2 MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL PARISH MEETING HELD ON 23 APRIL 2019

3 THE STATEMENT OF INCOME & EXPENDITURE FOR THE YEAR 2020-21

The Clerk gave a brief summary of income and expenditure for the financial year.

4 THE ANNUAL REPORT ON THE WORK OF THE PARISH COUNCIL 2020-21

The Chairman, Cllr Kimber reported on the activities of the Council during the past year, beginning by stating that it had been a strange year with no physical meetings but that the council had continued to function via monthly remote meetings. The two main issues of concern during the year were those surrounding the use of Lumb Falls and the tree felling in Hardcastle Crag. Cllr Kimber went on to state that despite these issues, communications with Calderdale and the National Trust had improved.

During the past couple of years five valuable members of the council, who had served the parish for many years, had resigned/retired from the council. A special mention was made in relation to David Bell, who resigned/retired from the Council in November 2020 having made a tremendous contribution to the council during his 47 years of service.

Cllr Kimber went on to thank everyone, and in particular the four new Cllrs for their contributions during a difficult year
